The new Clinic facility is taking shape right before our eyes. The footprint now stands in what was just a hole in the earth a few weeks ago. Most recently, volunteer construction crews began erecting steel beams, which has provided the first glimpse of our future home. Each step in the construction process brings the new Clinic to life a little more. We are deeply grateful to everyone who has contributed to the project since excavation began last Fall!

As the building starts to take shape, we're still eagerly fundraising for the *Keeping the Promise: Building Hope* capital campaign. We're pleased to share that as of June 6, 2023, we have raised \$9.5 million (or 76%) of our \$12.5 million goal, thanks to over 1,950 supporters that provided cash, pledges, or in-kind commitments. Of the total raised, more than \$1.6 million of labor and materials have been donated or pledged – a powerful testament to the tireless work and dedication of volunteers who comprise our gifts-in-kind and capital campaign committees.

Alongside the construction process, we will continue to raise the remaining \$3 million needed to reach our goal. Our next major fundraising milestone is to complete the campaign by March 2024. If you are receiving this newsletter, you've likely already contributed to the campaign; we are very grateful for your support. None of this work would be possible without you!

We will continue to share progress reports about the construction process and capital campaign. Please share these updates with your family and friends so they have an opportunity to support your and our efforts to complete the funding by the time the building is ready for occupancy. Enjoy the series of photographs below showing the early progression of construction. We look forward to sharing more construction updates in our Fall campaign newsletter.

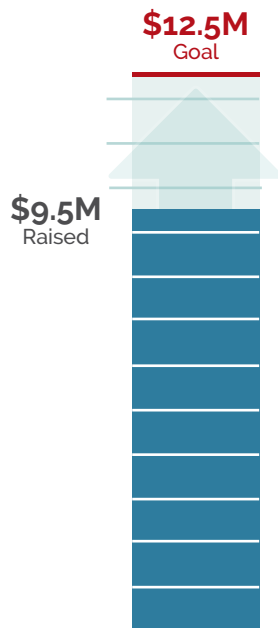

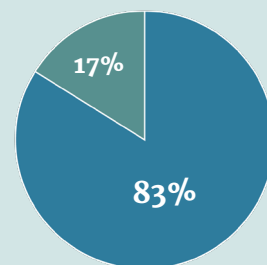

The Gifts-in-Kind Wheel of Progress

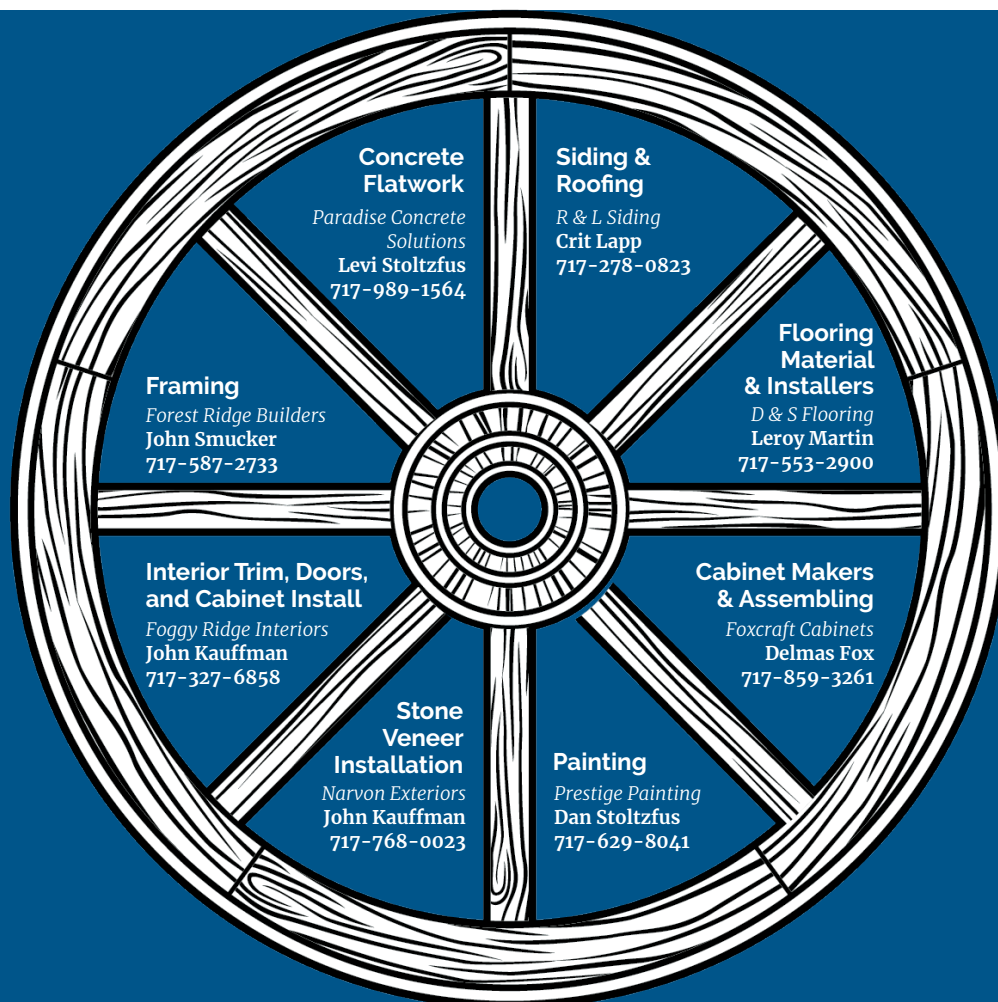
